



Engineering Technology Program - Enrollment Criteria for Incoming 9th Grade Students

Please observe the following criteria during enrollment of any 9th grade students into the Engineering Technology program (in order of importance):

- Student should have a strong interest in, demonstrate aptitude in, and/or have participated in, technical-related subject matter/topics/clubs or teams
- All incoming 9th graders should have completed Algebra in the 8th grade with a “B” or better
- Current English grades should be a “B” or better

These criteria are required for incoming Engineering Technology Program students to ensure they:

- 1. are able to handle the rigor of the Program curriculum*
- 2. can meet the demands of college entrance requirements and;*
- 3. can meet (and even exceed) employability standards in technical fields.*

Although difficult to assess upon enrollment it is also preferred that incoming students possess:

- strong communication and/or interpersonal skills
- be of strong moral and ethical character
